## **BRIEF AND TO THE POINT**

This Church office becomes, by nature, a very individualistic position, reflecting the desires and concerns of the one you elect each year. It falls victim to occasional criticism, but neverthe-less is a very rewarding experience. The most disappointing aspect is having to experience a distrust by some Church members regarding editorial decisions and a "think bad intentions first" attitude by those who feel they have been wronged by one of my decisions. On the other hand, the glimpses into the resulting good some of an editors decisions have made, and the hope that, in the long run, other decisions made will result in a higher quality missionary periodical for the advancement of Christ's Church, make it all worthwhile.

Starting this month, two new series will be started. They both deal with similar subject matter. Another series was started a few months ago and will continue another few months. It is my hope that the new editor will feel inclined to continue these series as I feel that each one is very worthy of each Advocate reader's full attention. 

## TESTIFY TO THE TRUTH OF THE BOOK



Many exciting discoveries are even now taking place in the field of New World archaeology. Those of us who have placed our faith in the *Book of Mormon* anxiously await reports from such developing sites as the ancient Mayan city of El Mirador, situated near the Guatemala-Mexico border. Sometimes we are somewhat dismayed, however, when preliminary reports appear carrying dates that seem to fall well outside the realm of those dictated by the narrative of the *Book of Mormon*.

I was, therefore, greatly interested in an article that appeared in the February 1988 edition of *Natural History*. This article, entitled "Geofacts and Fancy", was written by an archaeological geologist named C. Vance Haynes. Dr. Haynes was equally dismayed by the way many archaeologists have been apparently deceived by natural phenomena and, hence, applied dates that were often misleading to archaeological finds. From his numerous experiences in the field Dr. Haynes observed, "...how often natural processes produce objects easily mistaken for the work of humans. For such products of geological processes I coined the term geofacts."

The more common problem encountered seems to be the misinterpretation of the data observed or gathered. Dr. Haynes was invited to participate in a study of Tule Springs, Nevada which has received a lot of attention as being the oldest site of human presence in the New World. Here archaeologists have reported the finding of bones of extinct animals and human artifacts found in the same level in charcoal hearths. Using radio-carbon dating techniques this charcoal was dated at 28,000 years. A blueribbon panel of experts, sponsored by the National Science Foundation, authenticated each find.

Upon investigation of the site Dr. Haynes made some disturbing discoveries. He writes "...as site geologist I was surprised to find that what had been interpreted as charcoal hearths were in fact black deposits of incompletely fossilized plants...And what had been interpreted as fire-reddened earth by Apostle Donald McIndoo

turned out to be iron oxide stains produced by ground water."

Most importantly, he discovered "...that the bones of extinct animals whose fractures had been interpreted as the result of human work...were instead the product of trampeling by animals that had been trapped in the spring feeders."

Dr. Haynes sums up his study of this area with a most interesting conclusion: "Much of the evidence for pre-Clovis human presence involves either questionable artifacts or their association with localized cave or spring deposits... Here the only criterion for age is radio-carbon dating. If I learned one thing in a quarter century of direct involvement in radio-carbon dating, it is that radio-carbon dates can be wrong."

It is reassuring to see such forthrightness as the expressions of Dr. Haynes. Let me be equally forthright. If there should come to light from time-to-time "well-substantiated" claims for settlement in the New World by peoples not chronicled in the *Book of Mormon* or outside the dates prescribed by it, this in no way casts a shadow over the divinity of the book nor the historical accuracy of its treatment of the Jaredite and Nephite migrations.

Remember the all-important prophecy of Lehi: "...it is wisdom that this land should be kept as yet from the knowledge of other nations; for, behold, many nations would overrun the land, that there would be no place for an inheritance (2 Ne 1:16-17)." Yet even while Lehi was revealing this promise of the Lord, another nation, unknown to him, was concluding 1600 years of brilliant civilization in the New World.

A key element to the promise God made to Lehi was that the land to which his party had been led was unencumbered by other people and they were free to make of their "new world" what they would. Another vital key to his prophecy was that those who were led here "...would be brought by the hand of the Lord (verse 10)." Who knows how many peoples the Lord has brought, and will yet bring, to this land

#### of promise?

Yet another element of God's promise concerning this land was that "... whatsoever nation shall possess it, shall serve God, or they shall be swept off...(Ether 1:31)." This vital part of prophecy certainly helps account for such temporary settlements as those of the Vikings in their New World "Vinland" and perhaps many another colony whose history is in no other way referred to in the *Book of Mormon*. Yet another evidence of the divine plan behind the promised land as revealed by this marvelous record! We have every reason to be confident and no need to be narrow in our point of view.

(This article is to be the first of a series of short articles under this by-line which will endeavor to review archaeological, linguistic or historical evidence that attests to the truth of the *Book of Mormon*.)

## THE TESTIMONY OF THE AMERICAN INDIAN AND THE STICK OF JOSEPH

(This is the first part of a series about the North, Central and South American Indian and the Book of Mormon, which will be published monthly in *Zion's Advocate* at least through the calendar year 1989. While it is lengthy, it will be well worth your attention throughout. Editor.)

#### PART ONE

"In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established" (2 Corinthians 13:1).

The following treatise is a collection of wonderful proofs compiled to aid the student of the Book of Mormon. I do not present all the material which is available on the subject, however, I do present a good cross-section of the material now available.

Since Christ is the central theme throughout the Book of Mormon, it would seem that there should be no want of evidence of this fact among the American Indian. And so it is. There is an abundance of traditions handed down by the many tribes of this land (both north and south) telling of the visitation among them of a bearded white God.

For the benefit of those who may not be familiar with the Book of Mormon, we will begin by giving the record of Christ's visit among the early inhabitants of this land, followed by the writings of the various authors regarding the visitation of this great teacher among the ancestors of our American Indians.

According to the Book of Mormon, Christ made His appearance among the people of America shortly after His ascension into Heaven from Jerusalem. He came to fulfill His prophetic statement of John 10:16 that He had other sheep which were not of this fold (the fold at Jerusalem) and that they, too, were to hear His voice. The following is a summary of His visit as it is found in the Book of Mormon.

In the fifth chapter of Helaman we find an account of a prediction which was to begin to have its fulfillment five years from then. The prediction was to the effect that Christ was to be born into the world to redeem all those who would believe on Him. Among many heavenly signs that were to be given to show His birth was that a new star was to arise. After this the prophet went on to give another sign, the sign of His death. A great and terrible storm was to arise and the earth to shake and tremble causing tremendous destruction. The sun, moon and stars were also to withdraw their shining for the space of three days. The whole face of the land was to become altered because of the greatness and severity of the destruction.


The fourth chapter of 3rd Nephi gives the account of the fulfillment of the latter sign, that is, the sign of his death. The prophecy was fulfilled in every detail. A great and terrible storm arose in the 34th year, in the first month, in the fourth day of the month, such a storm as never had been known in all the land. And there were many tempests and whirlwinds, terrible thunder and exceeding sharp lightnings and a shaking of the whole earth. Many of the cities took fire and burned, others sank into the sea and still others were covered by great heaps of earth. The whole face of the land was changed, the highways were broken up, the rocks were rent in twain and broken up upon the face of the whole earth, inasmuch that they were ever after found in broken fragments, seams and in cracks. And the slain of the Lord were many. Then when the storm and guaking of the earth ceased there was darkness upon the whole face of the land. It was a thick darkness, a vapor of darkness so that there was no light seen for the space of three days, neither sun, moon or stars, nor could any fire be kindled. The people howled and lamented for their sins all across the land. And then there was a voice heard throughout all the land saying, "wo, wo, wo unto this people; wo unto the inhabitants of the whole earth, except they shall repent. For the devil laugheth, and his angels rejoice, because of the slain of the fair sons and daughters of my people; and it is because of their iniquity and abominations that they are fallen ... O all ye that are spared, because ye were more righteous than they, will ye not now return unto me, and repent of your sins, and be converted, that I may heal you?...Behold I am Jesus Christ, the Son of God...And the scriptures, concerning my coming, are fulfilled." And many other things did this voice speak unto the people.

The three days at length passed away and the darkness dispersed from off the earth and it was in the morning. Then in the fifth chapter of 3rd Nephi we find the people gathered about the temple in the land Bountiful wondering and marvelling one with another concerning the things which had just passed. And as they were doing so they heard a voice as if it came out of heaven which they did not at first understand. It was not a harsh voice nor a loud one, but notwithstanding it being a small voice, it did pierce them to the center, to the very soul. Then casting their eyes toward heaven they understood the voice.

And it said unto them, Behold, my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased, in whom I have glorified my name, hear ye him. And it came to pass as they understood, they cast their eyes up again towards heaven; and behold, they saw a man descending out of heaven; And he was clothed in a white robe; and he came down and stood in the midst of them, and the eyes of the whole multitude were turned upon him, and they durst not open their mouths, even one to another, and wist not what it meant, for they thought it was an angel that had appeared unto them. And it came to pass that he stretched forth his hand, and spake unto the people, saying, Behold I am Jesus Christ, of whom the prophets testified should come into the world; And behold I am the light and the life of the world, and I have drunk out of that bitter cup which the Father hath given me, and have glorified the Father in taking upon me the sins of the world, in the which I have suffered the will of the Father in all things, from the beginning. And it came to pass that when Jesus had spoken these words, the whole multitude fell to the earth, for they remembered that it had been prophesied among them that Christ should show himself unto them after his ascension into heaven. And it came to pass that the Lord spake unto them, saying, Arise and come forth unto me, that ye may thrust your hands in my side, and also that ye may feel the prints of the nails in my hands, and in my feet, that ye may know that I am the God of Israel and the God of the whole earth, and have been slain for the sins of the world. And it came to pass that the multitude went forth, and thrust their hands into his side, and did feel the prints of the nails in his hands and in his feet; and this they did do, going forth one by one, until they had all gone forth, and did see with their eyes, and did feel with their hands, and did know of a surety, and did bear record, that it was he, of whom it was written by the prophets, should come. (3 Nephi 5:1-16).

The foregoing is a brief account of the visit of Christ to America as it is given to us in the Book of Mormon. Is it true or false?

#### A Beast From The Sea

"And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy. And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power and his seat, and great authority". Rev. 13:1,2


In prophetic terminology, the word "beast" is an allusion to a nation. The particular nation is thus obscured, except as further described; the beast is Rome. Coming "out of the sea" alludes to the multitudes of the people of the world. This beast of Revelation 13 was like a leopard, yet had the feet of a bear and a lion's mouth. It had seven heads and ten horns. We are struck with the similarity of this beast to the four beasts of Daniel 7; in fact, the beasts of Daniel 7 describe a succession of empires beginning with Babylon and followed by that of the Medes and Persians, the Greek and finally, Roman. The beast of Revelation 13 was a composite of all these empires displaying the same characteristics, i.e., autocracy, idolatry and persecution. The latter kingdom (Rome) was situated on seven hills (the seven heads), and was later divided into ten nations (the ten horns) after its destruction as an empire. For an elaboration on this, see "A Marvellous Work And A Wonder", pp. 58-63. As Daniel considered the horns of the fourth beast (Dan. 7:8), he saw a little horn come up among the ten, which had "eyes like a man, and a mouth speaking great things". In the horns is the power of a beast, but Daniel saw that this fourth beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame", "because of the great words which the horn spake" (Dan. 7:11). The beast was pagan Rome which became divided into ten kingdoms, among which another power developed. This power (little horn) was to "speak great words against the most High" and to "wear out the saints of the most High" (Dan. 7:25). It was the papacy, the man of sin, and is the beast of Revelation 13 which had "a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies" (some of which we have previously recorded); he is the head of modern Babylon. This "beast" of Revelation 13 is illustrative of both pagan and papal Rome.

#### **Persecutor Of The Saints**

Just as Nebuchadnezzar of ancient Babylon persecuted and subjected the kingdom of Judah, so also has the "man of sin", or the papacy, as the head of mystic Babylon been responsible for the persecution, torture and death of millions of people - people who were innocent of crime except as they were accused of heresy.

The following from the writings of Rev. Scott in his Bible commentary will illustrate our point ("The Seven Kingdoms," p. 76):

"No computation can reach the numbers who have been put to death in different ways on account of their maintaining the profession of the gospel and opposing the corruption of the Church of Rome. A million of the poor Waldenses perished in France; nine hundred thousand orthodox Christians were slain in less than thirty years after the institution of the Jesuites. The Duke of Alva boasted of having put thirty-six thousand to death in The Netherlands, by the hand of the common executioner, during the space of a few years. The Inquisition destroyed by tortures, one hundred and fifty thousand Christians, within thirty years.



"These are a few specimens, and but a few of those which history has recorded; but the total amount will never be known till the earth shall disclose her blood, and shall no more cover her slain. These were put to death by the secular arm; by that power of which the empire was head, and which subsisted in kings and emperors as the executioners of its murderous decrees!"

Motley, in his "Rise of the Dutch Republic" (part 3, chap. 3) informs us:

"Upon February 16, 1568, a sentence of the Holy Office condemned all the inhabitants of The Netherlands to death as heretics. From this universal doom only a few persons,

A proclamation of the king dated ten days later, confirmed this decree of The Inquisition, and ordered it to be carried into instant execution, without regard to age, sex, or condition. Three millions of people, men, women and children, were sentenced to the scaffold in three lines."

These items of historical facts fulfill, in part at least, Rev. 12:17 where we are told that-

"... the dragon (devil, w.a.s.) was wroth with the woman (true Church of Christ, w.a.s.) and went to make war with the remnant of her seed which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ."



It is true that these terrible persecutions were carried into effect by kings and nations, but these were under the direction of the papacy and the college of cardinals; of which more will be given later.

Dan. 7:25 tells us the "little horn" would "wear out the saints of the most High", and Rev. 12:17 speaks of the dragon (devil) making war with them. Remember that we have discussed the church of the devil; he uses human instrumentality in many instances to perform his wicked designs against Christ and His people. In this case, the tools for his labor began under direction of the papacy, or "one who sitteth in the temple of God (the acknowledged church of God among the nations, w.a.s.), shewing himself that he is God" (2 Thess. 2:4). From the

With our love in the Gospel, Robert Jensen This text does not specify Babylon, but it says that those who fight against Zion are "the whore of all the earth", and this ties directly to Rev. 17:1 and 5, in which "Babylon the Great, the Mother of Harlots and Abominations of the Earth" is also called, "the great whore that sitteth upon many waters" (nations,

w.a.s.). Who are the "harlots", of whom Babylon is mother? If we consider only the religious aspects, it should be evident that the harlots are those churches which originated in the "great whore" (Rev. 17:1): the entire Protest movement, or in other words, the protestant churches! These in turn have spawned a multiplicity of children (churches) and non-denominational sects, which continue to divide and sub-divide endlessly, or so it seems.

Joseph Smith was told to join none of those churches of his day as their creeds (doctrines) were an abomination in the Lord's sight. And what can we think of the increasing division within the Restoration, the latter day saint churches? God is no more the author of confusion in religious Babel than He is of political/economic Babel.

Remember: Babel (Babylon) IS confusion. The spirit of confusion, or division, comes through the father of lies, the devil. It basically reflects the underlying, greater spirit of rebellion, a rebellion against God. Its companion is pride and selfexaltation; and this goes right back to Lucifer in the beginning, who was consumed with ambition; he became Satan, the devil, and was cast down because of it; and not only he, but a third of the heavenly host. This same proud, rebellious spirit is possessed by multitudes of mankind, and is the reason why Babylon must fall.

The papacy and the Vatican is in the forefront, a conspicuous part of Babylon, but it consists of all systems and people which "fight against Zion", which are antagonistic to the saints of God, which would subject the nations to slavery, or bring them into bondage, whether temporally or spiritually.

We have seen that the "beast" of Rev. 13:1 was, firstly, pagan Rome, but with its dissolution, papal Rome continued as the city upon "seven mountains"; ecclesiastical Rome survived and supplanted civil Rome as the dominant force in Europe. The "beast" was a dual or composite creature, but to all intents and purpose, was only one being.

Following the appearance of this beast, John said-

"And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon. And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. And he doeth great wonders, so that he maketh fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men, and deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by the sword, and did live. And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed. And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads." Rev. 13:11-16.

This second beast had two horns like a lamb, but spoke like a dragon. The symbolism of a lamb and a dragon are significant: the lamb being a false representation of the Lamb of God, while the dragon represents the devil (Rev. 12:9), or an ambassador of Satan. The beast's appearance was that of peace and righteousness, while from inside the heart issued the voice, the purpose of the devil. This beast was a combination of civil and ecclesiastical authority (the two horns), whose intent was the implementation of the papal will by the sword, and was fulfilled by Frankish kings of Europe in support of the papacy.

The word "Franks" (as denoting a people which came to power in the eighth century A.D. against the Lombards who had finally overthrown the Roman empire) is the root word for France. Charles, the most notable Frankish king, seized all the Lombard possessions, made himself king and gave these lands, or much of it, to the pope, who in turn conferred upon him the title, "Patrician of Rome", and—

"For a period of nearly 1,000 years, the papacy or Holy See held temporal possessions over which it exercised despotic political control" (Lincoln Library of Essential Information, p. 1466.)

In 800 A.D., Charles (also known as Charlemagne) gave further military support to Pope Leo III, which resulted in that pope crowning him as "Augustus, crowned by God, great and pacific emperor of the Romans", and referred to him as the "successor of Augustus and Constantine".

This civil/ecclesiastical combination was the foundation of the "Holy Roman Empire", which at the behest of popes, imposed the papal will upon the principal nations of Europe, and great was the destruction of the innocents as previously described. This empire was what we have termed, the second beast. Remember that this beast had two horns as a lamb, and these are symbols for the "beast" (the papacy) and the "false prophet" (a succession of kings in the Holy Roman empire) as referenced in Revelation 16:13 and 19:20.

In regard to the great wonders or miracles performed by this beast (vs. 13,14): the ability to make fire come down from heaven and other miracles is a matter of conjecture, but it is noteworthy that the appearance of comets in medieval times was superstitiously viewed by the masses as having significance in the affairs of men, foreboding signs of evil consequence, etc. However, it must be borne in mind that the devil has great power to deceive, and such celestial sights or other phenomena are within his realm of performance, and may have been exercised to a great extent in those times of the existence of the Holy Roman Empire.

### MINNEAPOLIS NEWS

During the October 2 Sacrament Meeting Pastor Thomas Maley's remarks were in part, "We shall partake of the emblems of our Lord Jesus Christ at this hour. He has promised that if we in this manner remember Him, in the moment we face God He will remember us. We will remember that body he wore. He wore it and still wears it. It is alive! I remember in my heart He is Alive and He is interested in our success in meeting His Father in the judgment. We shall have this bread: "It was broken because His will was broken. That which was human in Him was caused to entirely do the will of His Father." And of the wine: "In this emblem we realize more than in any of the rest of the ceremony perhaps the fact that Jesus Christ died to establish the resurrection of all mankind. When His blood was shed that was the final thing. He went to the other side where He would have power to rise again. This did two things that were wonderful: the grave will not hold us; and when we partake of these emblems it is always our belief and assurance that we shall face the day of judgment. Perhaps this is the reason we are here, because of the certainty of that Day and the belief that we should be able to face it successfully."

Pastor Thomas Maley was our speaker on October 9. He spoke of the matter of his repeating what seems to be old material; but which helps us remember who we are as a church and a people. distinct from other churches and other people as found in the Book of Mormon, pages 84 and 85. He made the point of the Book of Mormon having come to us as a result of an angel working with human beings of average intelligence to restore the understanding of things which were before. The great diversity of religions requires us to distinguish ourselves from them. One of our distinctions was our understanding of the principle of baptism. (We were away that Sunday and were furnished our information by Brother Merlin.)

On October 23, Priest John Gill asked Nana to draw on the board a woman being burned at the stake. Brother John brought readings from 2 Nephi 12:8, Mormon 3:17-23, Moroni 4:2-6, Alma 16:229, Alma 19:104, and Mormon 4:34-41.
