uring the ministry of Apostle Leon Yates in Yucatan there were times when his arrest and expulsion from the country seemed imminent. Some enemv of the Church of Christ had filed charges against the church as being connected with the KKK, and specific charges against Brother Yates as doing things detrimental to the well-being of Mexico. At times his freedom was guaranteed only by Divine intervention. An example of one such instance occurred when he and Elder Don McIndoo were driving to the town of Chunhuhúb in the territory of Quintana Roo to attend a church service that night. On the next morning they had to leave this town early because they had an appointment for a morning service in Peto, a town back in Yucatan. To return to Yucatan they had to pass through an Immigration checkpoint, the same checkpoint where authorities had threatened his arrest previously.

Elder McIndoo was driving as they entered Quintana Roo and Brother Yates was sitting in the passenger seat. Suddenly Brother Yates sat upright with a startled look on his face; he had just experienced an open vision. In this vision he was shown the very checkpoint they had recently passed and would have to check through again on the morrow. In the heavens above the checkpoint on the highway, he saw printed the word, DAN-GER, in large letters. No stranger to experiences with the Holy Spirit, Brother Yates knew the Lord had warned him of impending danger at this checkpoint. After the services in Chunhuhúb that evening, the two began a long journey which would allow them to enter Yucatan by another, lesser used route. They traveled until after midnight, caught a few hours sleep and were on the road again before daybreak. They had to travel many miles on an unknown, unpaved *sac be* (white limestone road) to reach their destination. Fifteen minutes before Sunday School was to begin in Peto they arrived at the home where services were to be held, very tired but safe and thanking the Lord.

everal years ago Brother Plácido had a very meaningful dream. In this dream he was walking on a trail in the forest. Suddenly the trail opened up onto a large field where several men were harvesting. In the middle of this large field were two flagpoles, one flying the Mexican flag and the other an American flag.

Directly in front of Plácido was a young man dressed in white clothing sitting on a rock while reading a book. Seeing Brother Plácido emerge from the forest he stood up and approached him. Extending the book, the young man said, "Here, read this." Plácido read the passage, which he recognized as a writing of the Prophet Isaiah, but the book in the hand of the young man was the Book of Mormon. He read the words indicated by the young man.

"And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people: to it shall the Gentiles seek:

and his rest shall be glorious. n the late 1970's I had an unforgettable experience that came to me as an answer to prayer. I had previously passed through several experiences that caused some consternation in my mind about the subject of the "rapture." At that time I had given little, if any, thought to this subject, nor had I heard any of our ministry teaching about it.

One night, following one of these experiences, I earnestly asked the Lord to show me the

uesday morning found Apostle Jay Moser and myself in our hotel room in Danli. Honduras. We were beginning the day with prayer when a knock came at our door. It was Brother Tommy Gill, and he told us we needed to go down to the lobby and watch the TV. As we did so. those terrible scenes of the devastation of September 11th were indelibly imprinted upon my mind. I cried bitter tears as I contemplated the possible withdrawal of one of God's great promises to America: "And this land shall be a land of liberty unto the Gentiles: and there shall be no kings upon the land, who shall raise up unto the Gentiles. And I will fortify this land against all other nations;" (II Nephi 7:18, 19).

In shock I watched a man free-falling after he had leaped from one of the devastated towers. He seemed to fall forever, and as I closed my eyes to remove the image from my sight, I heard a voice speak to my mind, as clearly as if it had been audible: "Revelation Sixteen, Verse Twelve." That is all I heard, but I could sit there no longer without going to our room to read this passage:

"And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared."

As I sit at my desk writing this late in the year 2003, it is difficult to predict what events will take place in the future. We presently find the United States, with but a few allies, still struggling against terrorists in Afghanistan while engaged in a deadly war with Iraq, the nation presently identified with the River Euphrates. Their objective is to break and remove the power of her despotic ruler which, as yet, has not been accomplished. n the fall of 1998, while I was still employed with the City of Phoenix Police Department, I sat at my desk one morning doing paperwork when I had an unexpected experience. In my had mind Ι а perfect understanding of a great work in Africa of which I was involved. I distinctly could see a large number of people coming from every direction out of a tropical jungle to a gathering place. These people came with great enthusiasm to hear the gospel

taught to them by the Church of Christ. After a few moments the experience ceased, but a vivid recollection of the event remained. I pondered the scene for some time, then tried to dismiss the experience, knowing full well we had no plans or contacts in Africa. I reasoned within myself that I must have been thinking about the work in Honduras, Honduras being a tropical area where people seem to be eager to hear the gospel preached.

The memory of this event never seemed to fade from my mind. I would occasionally mention to my wife how I would be going to Africa some day, which was usually met by a response that questioned my sanity. During the following months the Lord unmistakably revealed it was time for me to retire, and since it was not a financially sound concept I would have to put my trust in Him.

In the town of Kisii, located in Kenya, lives a young mother named Margaret Moraa Osaka. Margaret had been praying and searching for a church which taught the gospel according to Christ's doctrines and not man's. As close as I can estimate, in the fall of 1998, Margaret also had an experience, which I will relate.

During the night the Lord spoke to her and directed her to go to her father's home where she would find a particular book in his library. She was to contact the church on the inside cover. Margaret recognized the book from seeing it in her youth....

When Margaret opened the book she found on the inside cover that it had been published by the Church of Christ (Temple Lot), in Independence, Missouri. Margaret spoke to her father about the experience, and he encouraged her to do as the Lord had directed and contact this church....

On May 7th, 2000, Brother Smith Brickhouse and I attended the first service in Kisii, Kenya. We met with Margaret, her husband Samwell, her father Osaka and mother Nina, in the village of Kababe. We walked out across a field cleared out of a tropical jungle to a congregation of about a hundred people, who came from their villages located in all directions around Kababe. I marveled, as I now looked upon the very image I had experienced in my mind since the fall of 1998.

n December 28, 1988, Apostle (who was an Evangelist at the time) Placido Koyoc Yam awoke early in the morning. While praying over the day's activities, a vision appeared before him. He first saw his family, then all his brothers and sisters in his congregation that represented to him the church at large. He was overcome with the impression that there was a great need within the church. With this awareness the vision faded and, as he pondered the significance of what he had seen, there came to his mind, one by one, a list of needs for which he thought we should be praying. He listed them together with a few scriptures that came to his mind:

• Pray that the Lord of the harvest will send laborers into the vineyard.

his is a dream that I had one night. I am not sure of the exact date but it was late June or early July. The dream was not long before the Tri-State Reunion on 7 July 2006.

would like to tell about a dream I had in December, 1983. In this dream I dreamt that:

I awoke to an awful feeling of evil all about me. At first I was very casual about praying for the evil spirit to go away. The evil spirit became stronger, even to the point that my entire body was being shaken violently. I began praying diligently for the evil power to go away, but still it remained and became even stronger until I feared for my spiritual life. It was not until I rebuked this evil power to leave me in the name of Jesus Christ that it finally left me, but it did not flee far. I knew that the evil spirit was watching me and waiting for me to weaken and rely on my own power, but he could not enter into the house or building I was in.

I dreamed that I got up and started my daily activities and I noticed my brother was laying beside me on the bed. He had not been wakened by the incident. I thought it was strange for him to remain sleeping even when the entire bed had been shaken violently. Then I noticed that I did not recognize him as my own brother but as <u>a</u> brother. I could not see his face and I believe this is indicative of a brother in the Church of Christ, still sleeping.

As I continued in my daily chores and activities in the house I was made aware that I was safe while I was in the house as long as I continued to call on the Lord for strength to keep the adversary outside.

The building I was in had windows all around it and I could see out in almost every direction into the vast darkness outside. The darkness outside was absolute, with nothing visible. I knew that Satan himself was outside—watching every move I made. Several times I looked up and saw his eves—just the red glow of those evil, beady eves watching me. I have never known such fear and terror in my entire life as when I saw those eyes watching, for just a moment, and then he would back away, disappear into the darkness, only to reappear somewhere else when I was not expecting it.

The next thing I remember...I was at church. I don't remember how I got there; I just knew I was safe. I knew Satan had no power within the church and I had no fear at all. I have never felt so secure and safe and happy in all my life as I did while being in the church with all the rest of my brothers and sisters in the gospel.

The words that were impressed upon our brother Apostle Don Housknecht were also impressed on me. Before my eyes was a message, the words were burning before me, and in my very soul. Never has anything been impressed upon me with such spiritual power. The words were... "WE WILL BE VICTORIOUS." The saints all around me were rejoicing and praising the Lord, serenely and humbly with an all-powerful love for all.

I awoke. My pillow was wet from sweat—and from tears of joy that had flooded me during the last part of my dream. I laid there in bed wide-awake, thinking about the things that had happened in the dream. "Was this a spiritual dream?" I prayed to God for an answer—I listened for Him when I finished praying—silence. I didn't hear His reply.

I looked at the digital LED on my clock radio. It was 3:27 A.M. I went back to sleep after thinking and praying a little longer. A couple of days went by and I continued to pray about the dream. I had to know if this was a spiritual dream from God and what its purpose was. I rehearsed the dream in my mind. I felt the exact same fear and terror and evil as in the original dream. I went on and felt the same joys and happiness and security and love of the, and from the, Master. I saw the same words, "WE SHALL BE VIC-TORIOUS." I saw the same brother sleeping. I even had the same wet pillow. I prayed again that I would know if this was from God. Again I looked the clock...3:27 A.M. The spirit of God flooded my soul and tears of joy flooded my face—my heart was burning and felt like it was going to explode.

I remembered looking at the clock the night the dream (was given?) right after I had praved for an answer from God about the dream. I felt that I had received my answer but still the number 327 stayed in my mind as if it were significant of something else. I thought and prayed about it for several days. Then I remembered the song, The Fight is On, that had been given to me in the dream. I thought maybe this was the number of a song that was significant to this dream. I looked and read #327 in the green hymnal and it didn't have any special meaning to me. I looked up #327 in our red hymnal and started reading the words to "Leaning On The Everlasting Arms." It wasn't until the last verse that the words seemed to jump off the page at me— "What have I to dread? What have I to fear, leaning on the everlasting arms?" I knew without a doubt that was the intended meaning.

I thought about the things relating to the dream quite a lot the next several days and prayed that I might have a full understanding of all the events of the dream.

On the next Sunday morning I was listening to the announcements and when they were given it was impressed upon my mind to ask the scheduled speaker if I could take his place the following Sunday morning. He agreed.

One of the things I felt led to speak about was our effort to do the things Christ said in His closing statement as recorded in the four gospels:

"Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you; and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen" Matthew 28:19 & 20.

"And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned" Mark 16:15-16.

"And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem" Luke 24:27.

"So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs. He saith to him again the second time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep. He saith unto him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep" John 21:15-17.

Christ must have felt they were very important if they were His final statements to His disciples while He was here teaching them.

I believe and am persuaded that the efforts of our missionary endeavors will begin to be more fruitful and rewarding of the promise that God has given us— "WE WILL BE VICTORI-OUS."

A CALL TO LEADERSHIP

n a discussion of those qualities essential to the life of a Christian leader, an important one is perhaps best exemplified by the words of 1 Samuel 17:48: When Goliath "...arose, and came, and drew nigh to meet David, that David hasted, and ran toward the army to meet the Philistine." Imagine, a youth with but a staff and a sling, running to do battle with a well-armed giant who had terrified the armies of Israel. The Philistines lost a champion and a battle that day, while Israel gained a warrior king who would make them a great nation.

Long before David's day the Lord had spoken to Moses and, later, to Joshua. These were the leaders of Israel who would establish God's people in the land of their inheritance. They would meet terrible opposition and both needed the same, necessary encouragement: "Be strong and of a good courage..." (Deuteronomy 31:6 and Joshua 1:6).

Today we face a different kind of enemy. Our adversary is much stronger and more dangerous than Goliath or the Canaanites of the Promised Land. "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:" (1 Peter 5:8). Satan has an array of warriors doing his bidding - the great and abominable church, followers of the false prophet, and a worldly culture which is deceiving the masses. This spiritual warfare demands a courage all its own. God's message comes

down to us from the pen of Isaiah:

"Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness. Behold, all they that were incensed against thee shall be ashamed and confounded: they shall be as nothing; and they that strive with thee shall perish" (Isaiah 41:10, 11).


The type of courage we need reminds me of the challenge of King David to his son, Solomon: "Take heed now; for the Lord hath chosen thee to build an house for the sanctuary: be strong, ... and of good courage, and do it: fear not, nor be dismayed: for the Lord God, even my God, will be with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee, until thou hast finished all the work for the service of the house of the Lord" (1 Chronicles 28:10, 20).

We, like Solomon, have been called to a great work. The Lord has called you out of the world and has chosen you to help build up His kingdom, to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to gather the lost sheep of Israel once again to the lands of their inheritance. If you would be a leader in this great work, keep these words of David in the forefront of your mind: "Be strong, and of good courage, and do it..."

Just as in the days of the apostles when the work went out to the Gentile world, there will be a lot of opposition, ridicule and, perhaps, persecution. We shall need the courage of the great leaders of that day, men like Peter and John. "And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. But Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye. For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard. So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all men glorified God for that which was done" (Acts 4:18-21).

In the first week of 2006 a young New York City fireman, just 28 years of age, passed away. In the terrible hours after the collapse of the twin towers, some four years earlier, he had remained on the site, working through the days in an effort to save any survivors. Now, his damaged lungs would function no more. And he was not alone. Many labored day after day, including Mayor Giuliani, showing the world, and showing the enemy the courage that has made us a great nation.

This is what we Christian leaders must do as well: Stand firmly in the face of danger, adversity or opposition. Let us follow the example of those early Lamanite Christians: "...the church was broken up in all the land, save it were among a few of the Lamanites, who were converted unto the true faith; And they would not depart from it, for they were firm, and steadfast, and immovable, willing with all diligence to keep the commandments of the Lord" (3 Nephi 3:15, 16).
