



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

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# WHAT IS GOD'S PLAN FOR

Twant to first start at the very beginning when God brought forth this land we know as America today. The first scripture I want to use can be found in the Book of Mormon from the book of Ether. The book of Ether is an abridgement that came from 24 gold plates found by the people of Limhi who came out of the land of Zarahemla (Mosiah 5:2, 64). The ancient writings upon

"Behold, this is a choice land, and whatsoever nation shall possess it, shall be free from bondage, and from captivity, and from all other nations under heaven, if they will but serve the God of the land, who is Jesus Christ who hath been manifested by the things which we have written" (Ether 1:35)

these plates of gold were translated by King Mosiah by the use of "interpreters" given to him by God (Mosiah 5:72-74; 12:14-26). The book of Ether is a record written by a people who were preserved by the hand of God during the day of the "great tower" where the "Lord confounded the language of the people" (Ether 1:7; Genesis 11:7). A spiritual leader who we know only as the "Brother of Jared," a man "highly favored of the Lord" (Ether 1:8-36), was asked by his brother to pray to God that their family and friends' language would not be confounded. The Lord had compas-

sion and granted the request made by the Brother of Jared. Another request was made by the Brother of Jared, if they were to be driven out of the land, that they might be driven to a choice land for their inheritance, since the Lord had said in His wrath, "they should be scattered upon all the face of the earth" (Ether 1:7; Genesis The Lord granted the Brother of Jared's request and led the people out of the land across the wilderness to a great sea. There they built barges as the Lord had directed them and sailed across the great sea to a choice land for their inheritance and became a mighty nation of people. The land that they inherited is described in the following scripture verse:

"... After the waters had receded from off the face of this land, it became a choice land above all other lands, a chosen land of the Lord:..." Ether 6:2.

According to the record contained on those 24 gold plates the Lord had reserved this land from the beginning of its existence to be a "...*choice* land above all other lands,...."

The word "choice" as defined can be used as a noun as in selection, distinct, or set apart. In this case God had made it known to the ancient inhabitants of the land and then to the world, when this record came forth in the Book of Mormon, that America was a land specifically chosen of God "above all other lands." Thus this land of America would be known to the world as the "choice" or "promised" land set apart with a specific identity above all other lands. I believe the following scripture clearly fits the definition of the word "choice" as a noun:

"Wherefore the Lord would have that all men should serve him, who dwell upon the face thereof; and that it was the place of the New Jerusalem, which should come down out of heaven, and the holy sanctuary of the Lord" Ether 6:3.

The quoted scripture speaks of "the New Jerusalem" and "the holy sanctuary of the Lord" being associated with

this land known to the world as America. The significance and importance of this understanding demands the proper acknowledgment and respect by those who occupy this hallowed land named by God as the "promised land" (Ether 3:14). It demands their reverence and obedience to the commandments of that God Who created them and the land they live upon, and who are the recipients of those blessings pronounced upon the land.

Now let us return to the definition of the word "choice." Choice can also be used as an adjective, as of superior quality; excellent, or carefully chosen. Again, as in this case, God used this word to describe the qualities that would be associated with this land that He chose for His purposes. Again, I believe the following scripture clearly fits the definition of the word "choice" as an adjective:

"Behold, this is a choice land, and whatsoever nation shall possess it, shall be free from bondage, and from captivity, and from all other nations under heaven, if they will but serve the God of the land, who is Jesus Christ who hath been manifested by the things which we have written" (Ether 1:35).

I will let the ancient inhabitants describe to you what the word "choice" meant to them as God blessed them upon this land of their inheritance:

"And they built a great city by the narrow neck of land, by the place where the sea divides the land. And they did preserve the land southward for a wilderness, to get game. And the whole face of the land northward was covered with inhabitants; and they were exceeding industrious, and they did buy and sell, and traffic one with another, that they might get gain. And they did work in all manner of ore. and they did make gold, and silver, and iron, and brass, and all manner of metals; and they did dig it out of the earth; wherefore they did cast up mighty heaps of earth to get ore, of gold, and of silver, and of iron, and of copper. And they did work all manner of fine work. And they did have silks, and fine twined linen; and they did work all manner of cloth, that they might clothe themselves from their nakedness. And they did make all manner of tools to till the earth, both to plow and to sow, to reap and to boe, and also to thrash. And they did make all manner of tools with which they did work their beasts. And they did make all manner of weapons of war. And they did work all manner of work of exceeding curious workmanship" (Ether 4:68-77).

What about those ancient ones (the Brother of Jared, his family, and their friends) that were led to this land for an inheritance and who were they? We believe that those ancient ones were the Olmec people who are known as the "mother culture of all Mesoamerica" (ref. A Book of Mormon Companion, Witnesses to its Validity, by Apostle Donald McIndoo, pages 173-189). According to the account recorded by Ether they became a very prosperous people and they were mightily blessed of God.

"And never could be a people more

blessed than were they, and more prospered by the hand of the Lord. And they were in a land that was choice above all lands, for the Lord had spoken it" (Ether 4:78-79).

Later the account turns to a darker period of time where the people of the land allowed sin and corruption to enter into their society. There were those who set about to overthrow the freedoms of the people to get gain and power. Over time they had cast aside their beliefs and the commandments of God. They had also cast off the prophets sent of God to call the people to repentance; therefore, God gave them up to their own devices and thev destroyed.

"And he had sworn in his wrath unto the Brother of Jared, that whoso should possess this land of promise, from that time henceforth and forever, should serve him, the true and only God, or they should be swept off when the fullness of his wrath should come upon them" (Ether 1:30).

Besides those who came after the great tower of Babel, who else was led to this choice land of America? The Book of Mormon tells of several other migrations that have taken place where God led others out of their homelands and brought them to this land of promise, America.

The descendants of Joseph:

"And it came to pass that my father Lehi also found upon the plates of brass a genealogy of his fathers; Wherefore he knew that he was a descendant of Joseph; yea, even that Joseph who was the son of Jacob, who was sold into Egypt, and who was preserved by the hand of the Lord, that he might preserve his father Jacob and all his household from perishing with famine" (1 Nephi 1:164-165).

# THE BLESSING FROM GOD

"But, said he, notwithstanding our afflictions, we have obtained a land of promise, a land which is choice above all other lands; A land which the Lord God hath covenanted with me should be a land for the inheritance of my seed. Yea, the Lord hath covenanted this land unto me, and to my children for ever; And also all those who should be led out of other countries, by the hand of the Lord. Wherefore, I, Lehi, prophesy according to the workings of the Spirit which is in me, that there shall none come into this land, save they shall be brought by the hand of the Lord" (2 Nephi 1:6-10).

# THE LAND OF PROMISE

"And it came to pass that I, Nephi, did guide the ship, that we sailed again towards the promised land. And it came to pass that after we had sailed for the space of many days, we did arrive to the promised land; And we went forth upon the land, and did pitch our tents; and we did call it the promised land. And it came to pass that we did begin to till the earth, and we began to plant seeds, yea, we did put all our seeds into the earth, which we had brought from the land of Jerusalem. And it came to pass that they did grow exceedingly; wherefore, we were blessed in abundance. And it came to pass that we did find upon the land of promise, as we journeyed in the wilderness, that there were beasts in the forests of every kind, both the

cow, and the ox, and the ass, and the horse, and the goat, and the wild goat, and all manner of wild animals, which were for the use of men. And we did find all manner of ore, both of gold, and of silver, and of copper" (1 Ne 5:211-217).

The descendants of Judah:

# **GENEALOGY**

"Behold, it came to pass that Mosiah discovered that the people of Zarahemla, came out from Jerusalem, at the time that Zedekiah, king of Judah, was carried away captive into Babylon" (Omni 1:26).

# THE BLESSING FROM GOD

"And they journeyed in the wilderness, and were brought by the hand of the Lord, across the great waters, into the land where Mosiah discovered them; and they had dwelt there from that time forth" (Omni 1:27).

# THE LAND OF PROMISE

"And they would no longer be called by the names of their fathers, therefore they took upon themselves the name of Nephi, that they might be called the children of Nephi, and be numbered among those who were called Nephites. And now all the people of Zarahemla were numbered with the Nephites, and this because the kingdom had been conferred upon none but those who were descendants of Nephi" (Mosiah 11:89-90).

Our forefathers:

# GENEALOGY

"And it came to pass that I looked and beheld many waters; and they divided the Gentiles from the seed of my brethren. And it came to pass that the angel said unto me, Behold the wrath of God is upon the seed of thy brethren! And I looked and beheld a man among the Gentiles, who was separated from the seed of my brethren by the many waters; and I beheld the Spirit of God, that it came down and wrought upon the man; and he went forth upon the many waters, even unto the seed of my brethren, who were in the promised land" (1 Nephi 3:145-147).

We believe that this scripture is a prophetic reference to Christopher Columbus and his eventual voyage and discovery of America. Columbus had been inspired by the prophecies of Isaiah found in the Bible concerning the "isles of the sea."

The original journal of Christopher Columbus has been lost, but much of it was retold by Bishop Bartolome de Las Casas, a sixteenth-century historian who was with Columbus in Espanola on his third voyage (ref. see also *Christopher* Columbus's Book of Prophecies, translated by Kay Brigham, Barcelona: Libros CLIE, 1991; and Delno C. West & August Kling (Translation & commentary 1991; The "Libro de las Profecias" of Christopher Columbus). The following excerpt is a translation by Cecil Jane, The Voyages of Christopher Columbus, pages 146, 147, as found in Peter Marshall and David Manuel's published book, The Light and the Glory (1977, page 17):

"It was the Lord who put into my mind (I could feel his hand upon me) the fact that it would be possible to sail from here to the Indies. All who heard of my project rejected it with laughter, ridiculing me. There is no question that the inspiration was from the Holy Spirit, because He comforted me with rays of marvelous inspiration from the Holy Scriptures...

"I am a most unworthy sinner, but I have cried out to the Lord for grace and mercy, and they have covered me completely. I have found the sweetest consolation since I made it my whole purpose to enjoy His marvelous presence. For the execution of the journey to the Indies, I did not make use of intelligence, mathematics or maps. It is simply the fulfillment of what Isaiah had prophesied...."

Columbus's voyages opened the door for Spain to come to the promised land, which before times was isolated by God to protect the current inhabitants from the world.

"And behold, it is wisdom that this land should be kept as yet from the knowledge of other nations; For, behold, many nations would overrun the land, that there would be no place for an inheritance" (2 Nephi 1:16-17).

There were other nations of people who left their nativity, following Spain's lead, that were brought by the hand of God to this promised land, America.

"And it came to pass that I beheld the Spirit of God, that it wrought upon other Gentiles; and they went forth out of captivity, upon the many waters. And it came to pass that I beheld many multitudes of the Gentiles upon the land of promise; And I beheld the wrath of God that it was upon the seed of my brethren; and they were scattered before the Gentiles, and were smitten. And I beheld the Spirit of the Lord, that it was upon the Gentiles; that they did prosper, and obtain the land for their inheritance;..." (1 Nephi 3:148-151).

# THE CURSE FROM GOD

The full impact of God's promise and curse associated with this choice land was to be realized upon the inhabitants of the land discovered by Columbus. You can read the firsthand account by Bernal Diaz del Castillo, Conquistador, memoir, The Discovery and Conquest of Mexico, who came after Columbus, conquered and brought under subjection those that they found upon the land. This was the beginning of "Wo" from God as promised to Lehi in the following:

"Behold, I say, If the day shall come that they will reject the Holy One of Israel, the true Messiah, their Redeemer and their God, behold, the judgments of him that is just, shall rest upon them; Yea, he will bring other nations unto them, and he will give unto them power, and he will take away from them the lands of their possessions, and he will cause them to be scattered and smitten" (2 Nephi 1:23-24).

# THE BLESSING FROM GOD

"Wherefore, this land is consecrated unto him whom he shall bring. And if it so be that they shall serve him according to the commandments which he hath given, it shall be a land of liberty unto them; Wherefore, they shall never be brought down into captivity: if so, it shall be because of iniquity: For if iniquity shall abound, cursed shall be the land for their sakes; But unto the righteous, it shall be blessed for ever" (2 Nephi 1:11-15).

# THE LAND OF PROMISE

"And it came to pass that I, Nephi, beheld that the Gentiles who had gone forth out of captivity did humble themselves before the Lord, and the power of the Lord was with them: And I beheld that their mother Gentiles were gathered together upon the waters, and upon the land also, to battle against them; And I beheld that the power of God was with them; and also that the wrath of God was upon all those that were gathered together against them to battle. And I, Nephi, beheld that the Gentiles that had gone out of captivity were delivered by the power of God out of the hands of all other nations. And it came to pass that I, Nephi, beheld that they did prosper in the land;..." (1 Nephi 3:152-156).

What was God's design in bringing about this last migration of people known as the Gentiles to this land of promise? The answer to this question can be found in the following scriptures which are contained in the Book of Mormon:

# GENTILES WILL HAVE THE RECORD OF THE JEWS (THE BIBLE)

"And I beheld a book, and it was carried forth among them. And the angel said unto me, Knowest thou the meaning of the book? And I said unto him, I know not. And he said, Behold, it proceedeth out of the mouth of a Jew; and I, Nephi, beheld it; And he said unto me, The book that thou beholdest is a record of the Jews, which contains the covenants of the Lord which he hath made unto the house of Israel; And it also containeth many of the prophecies of the holy prophets; And it

is a record like unto the engravings which are upon the plates of brass, save there are not so many; nevertheless, they contain the covenants of the Lord which he hath made unto the house of Israel; Wherefore, they are of great worth unto the Gentiles" (1 Nephi 3:157-164).

# GENTILES WILL HAVE THE RECORD OF THE SEED OF JOSEPH (THE BOOK OF MORMON)

"Wherefore, after I have visited them in judgment, and smitten them by the hand of the Gentiles; And after the Gentiles do stumble exceedingly because of the most plain and precious parts of the gospel of the Lamb which has been kept back, by that abominable church, which is the mother of barlots, saith the Lamb, I will be merciful unto the Gentiles in that day, insomuch that I will bring forth unto them in mine own power, much of my gospel, which shall be plain and precious, saith the Lamb; For behold, saith the Lamb, I will manifest myself unto thy seed, that they shall write many things which I shall minister unto them, which shall be plain and precious; And after thy seed shall be destroyed and dwindle in unbelief, and also the seed of thy brethren; behold, these things shall be hid up, to come forth unto the Gentiles by the gift and power of the Lamb; And in them shall be written my gospel, saith the Lamb, and my rock and my salvation;" (1 Nephi 3:182-186).

# GOD WILL SET UP A GENTILE NATION OF FREE PEOPLE ON THIS LAND, AMERICA

"Verily, verily, I say unto you, When these things shall be made known unto them of the Father, and shall come forth of the Father, from them unto you, for it is wisdom in the Father that they should be established in this land, And be set up as a free people by the power of the Father, that these things might come forth from them unto a remnant of your seed, that the covenant of the Father may be fulfilled which he hath covenanted with his people, O house of Israel" (3 Nephi 9:89-90).

The United States was the first nation in history, after a revolutionary war, where a free and independent people formed a nation that would elect their representatives instead of having a King or a Dictator by force rule over them.

# THE BOOK OF MORMON COMING FROM THE GENTILES TO THE REMNANT OF JACOB IS A SIGN FROM GOD

"And behold, this is the thing which I will give unto you for a sign, for verily I say unto you, that when these things which I declare unto you, and which I shall declare unto you hereafter of myself, and by the power of the Holy Ghost, which shall be given unto you of the Father, shall be made known unto the Gentiles, That they may know concerning this people who are a remnant of the house of Jacob, and concerning this my people who shall be scattered by them;" (3 Nephi 9:87-88).

"And when these things come to pass, that thy seed shall begin to know these things, it shall be a sign unto them, that they may know that the work of the Father hath already commenced unto the fulfilling of the covenant which he hath made unto the people who are of the house of Israel" (3 Nephi 9:93).

# GOD WILL ESTABLISH HIS CHURCH AND WILL MAKE A COVENANT WITH THE GENTILES

"For thus it behooveth the Father that it should come forth from the Gentiles, that he may shew forth his power unto the Gentiles, for this cause, that the Gentiles, if they will not harden their hearts, that they may repent and come unto me, and be baptized in my name, and know of the true points of my doctrine, that they may be numbered among my people, O house of Israel:" (3 Nephi 9:92).

"But if they will repent, and hearken unto my words, and harden not their hearts, I will establish my church among them, and they shall come in unto the covenant, and be numbered among this the remnant of Jacob, unto whom I have given this land for their inheritance,..." (3 Nephi 10:1).

# GOD WILL HAVE THE CITY NEW JERUSALEM BUILT UPON THIS CHOICE LAND, AMERICA

"...And they shall assist my people, the remnant of Jacob; And also, as many of the house of Israel as shall come, that they may build a city, which shall be called the New Jerusalem; And then shall they assist my people that they may be gathered in, who are scattered upon all the face of the land, in unto the New Jerusalem" (3 Nephi 10:1-3).

The coming forth of the Book of Mormon and the establishment of the Church of Christ by the authority given them of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Ghost in 1830 was the fulfillment of the words of Christ and prophecies as contained in the preceding

scripture verses. It must be noted that it was also the fulfillment of prophecy that is found in the Bible (Isaiah 29:9-24; Daniel 2:44-45; Revelation 14:6-7). There was no other nation that would have allowed a religious record as the Book of Mormon and the establishment of a church, the Church of Christ, based on the teachings of both the Bible and Book of Mormon, besides the United States. The other existing nations in 1830 were either under some other religious control and scrutiny, or dictatorship type of rule which would not have allowed those two things to come to light.

What do the Gentiles have to fear since God has set them up as a free nation above all other nations?

# THE CURSE

"And this cometh unto you, O ye Gentiles, that ye may know the decrees of God, that ye may repent, and not continue in your iniquities until the fullness come, that ye may not bring down the fullness of the wrath of God upon you, as the inhabitants of the land have bitherto done. Behold, this is a choice land, and whatsoever nation shall possess it, shall be free from bondage, and from captivity, and from all other nations under beaven, if they will but serve the God of the land, who is Jesus Christ who hath been manifested by the things which we have written" (Ether 1:34-35).

"And my people who are a remnant of Jacob, shall be among the Gentiles, yea, in the midst of them, as a lion among the beasts of the forest, as a young lion among the flocks of sheep, who, if he go through both treadeth down and teareth in pieces, and none can deliver. Their hand shall be lifted up upon their adversaries, and all their enemies shall be cut off. Yea, wo be unto the Gentiles, except they repent, for it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Father, that I will cut off thy horses out of the midst of thee, and I will destroy thy chariots, and I will cut off the cities of thy land, and throw down all thy strongholds;..." (3 Nephi 9:99-101).

From the beginning God's plan has been that a city called the New Jerusalem would be built upon this choice land of America. The New Jerusalem is to be built by the remnant of the seed of Joseph and by the chosen people of God who have a desire to keep His commandments, and who have made a covenant with Him to be His people. This land and the city New Jerusalem was a covenant that God made to Joseph of old (2 Nephi 2:5-6) who was sold into slavery by his brothers and who received the inheritance of the "first born" (1 Chronicles 5:1-2) of the house of Israel because of his faithfulness to God. Joseph's inheritance was a covenant from God where He would "...raise up a righteous branch unto the house of Israel;" (2 Nephi 2:7) and that "...righteous branch..." would occupy this land of promise given them of God (Jacob 2:34-35; 3 Nephi 7:13-14). Joseph was used by God to preserve the house of Israel during his days in Egypt, and God intends on using a remnant of the seed of Joseph to fulfill His purposes in preserving

the house of Israel in these Last Days.

By setting up the Gentiles upon this land as a free nation. God had fulfilled a prophecy that had been given to a descendant of Joseph whose name was Lehi (2 Nephi 1:8-10). God confirmed His covenant with Joseph (the son of Jacob) to Lehi where He would preserve this land for a remnant of the seed of Joseph "...for ever; ..." (2 Nephi 1:15), and would bring others to this land for His Divine purposes. I would submit to you that those "who should be led out of other countries, by the hand of the Lord" (2 Nephi 1:9) were our forefathers who were led and directed by God (confirmed by their own testimonies) to come to this land because they had a desire to be free to worship their God and to have the freedom of self government under God.

It has been 235 years since our founding fathers were joined together in congress, putting their signature to a document which declared their independence from Great Britain. The 56 men who signed their names to this declaration knew that this act was a critical first step of becoming a new nation. They had felt freedom's call to be a self-governed people where they would one day be a nation not under servitude to a self-proclaimed ruler or king, but a nation ruled by common consent of a free people. With their signatures affixed, declaring their independence, they reaffirmed their decision to each other and to the people that

they represented to be free under "...the protection of divine Providence...." They willingly offered their "...Lives, our Fortunes and our sacred Honor..." to the cause outlined in "The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America" to be free, independent states, separated from all outside influences and rule of law. Those men fully understood the implications by choosing freedom, being subjects under the British rule of law, they would be accused of heresy and sedition that carried the death penalty by the ruling monarchy of Great Britain.

How did a small, insignificant group of people stand against one of the most powerful nations of the time and ultimately succeed in becoming an independent nation? There have been many historians who have asked this question, but few have been able to accept the facts which point directly to Divine intervention. Those who gave their lives, fortunes, and their all with gratitude, acknowledged the intervention of something greater than themselves that had preserved them through their great struggle to become a free people. We now have a nation that has turned its back on the heritage given it with the passing of time; succeeding generations have failed to teach and impress upon their children the sacredness of the gift of freedom given them and from where that gift originates. even the God of this land, Jesus Christ. As a nation, we have allowed our children to be taught by historical revisionists who deny the existence of God and His purposes behind establishing a free nation under His rule.


In conclusion I want to use the words of Jesus Christ as found in the Book of Mormon that is a beckoning voice to the Gentiles who occupy this choice land, America.

"Hearken, O, ye Gentiles, and bear the words of Jesus Christ, the Son of the living God, which he hath commanded me that I should speak concerning you, for, behold be commandeth me that I should write, saying, Turn all ye Gentiles, from your wicked ways, and repent of your evil doings, of your lyings and deceivings, and of your whoredoms, and of your secret abominations, and your idolatries, and of your murders, and your priestcrafts, and your envyings, and your strifes, and from all your wickedness and abominations. And come unto me, and be baptized in my name, that ye may receive a remission of your sins, and be filled with the Holy Ghost, that ye may be numbered with my people, who are of the house of Israel" (3 Nephi 14:1-3).

# HIS MYSTERIOUS WAYS

# The Amazing Son of God

n the distant beginning before the creation of the heavens and the earth a singular event took place. The Father brought forth His Son. It was His only offspring. This fact is confirmed by reference to Revelation 3:14:

"And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; these things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God."

Christ Himself was the beginning of the creation of God.

Imagine the wonder of the God and Creator of the universe coming to this world as a mere babe in the womb of a mortal woman.

Thus He, and He alone, was called the Only Begotten of the Father, the Son of God.

It was through Christ that all the rest of creation was accomplished, for the Son created the heavens and the earth and all things that in them are. Then when we, who are His offspring, take upon us His name (the name of Christ) through the waters of baptism, we are spiritually begotten of Him as His sons and daughters.

"For behold, this day he hath spiritually begotten you; for ye say that your hearts are changed through faith on his name; therefore, ye are born of him, and have become his sons and his daughters" (Mosiah 3:9).

I once wondered how this could be, since Christ alone is the Only Begotten Son. Then it was that I realized that Christ *is*,

indeed, the Only Begotten of the Father, but the rest are begotten through Christ who both created and saved us. Such is the mystery of Godliness.

But think of the wonder of Christ. He appeared in the plains of Mamre to Abraham along with His Father. Abraham, lifting up his eyes, looked and beheld three men standing before him. And he went and bowed himself to the ground before them. God then revealed to Abraham what He was about to do, both by way of the promised offspring to Sarah, as well as His mission to Sodom and Gomorrah. Abraham entertained them with food and drink, after which two of them departed for Sodom.

Lot also recognized these visitors and refused to allow them to remain in the street, later offering his daughters to the men of the city in their stead. The next day the LORD called down fire from the LORD upon those wicked cities. It was the Son calling down fire from the Father. This thought is confirmed as the term *Elohim* is used, showing that the plurality of the Godhead was involved in this judgment.

Christ also appeared to Joshua as the captain of the Lord's hosts. Jacob wrestled with Him all night when he was journeying to his homeland. Christ also appeared to Moses and wrote the Ten Commandments on tablets of stone with His own finger. He appeared to the Brother of Jared when the Brother of Jared was beseeching God to touch the stones to give them light. He also led the children of Israel for 40 years as He abode in the cloud.

But the most marvelous thing was yet to transpire. It was the will of His Father that He come and offer Himself up as a sacrifice for His people. What an amazing thing this was, and how extraordinary. It was the very thing that caused the Jews to look beyond the mark. The mystery of Godliness is thus hid from the wise and prudent of this world, but revealed to babes.

Imagine the wonder of the God and Creator of the universe coming to this world as a mere babe in the womb of a mortal woman. Can you think how Mary must have felt, knowing she carried the Creator of the heavens and the earth within her own body? What a paradox that she should give birth to the very One who created her.

After His birth, brothers and sisters were also born to Mary. These were, in fact, half brothers and sisters to Jesus. Imagine how they must have felt when they realized that their sibling was the God of the whole earth.

The God of creation was born in humble circumstances and raised as a carpenter under his earthly (step) father. course, when Mary heard the words of the shepherds, she pondered them in her heart, remembering, no doubt, that the angel has previously told her that the Holy Ghost would come upon her and she would bring forth the Son of God. later, in the temple, Simeon came and uttered marvelous words concerning this child that caused Joseph and Mary to marvel at those things which were said. This was followed by the words of Anna.

Still later, when Joseph and Mary made a trip to Jerusalem, the child Jesus was left behind. Upon finding He was missing, they returned to search for Him, and after three days found Him in the temple astonishing the doctors with His understanding and answers. To His concerned parents He said, "How is it that ye sought me? Wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?" But Joseph and Mary did not understand this saying.

So Jesus grew up, being subject to His earthly parents until He arrived to the age of about thirty. By this time John the Baptist was preaching and baptizing, telling the people of

One who was to come after him whose shoes latchet he was not worthy to unloose. When the Lord came to him to be baptized, John deferred to Him, saying that he was not worthy, but rather that he should be baptized of Him. Herein is the awesome mystery of Godliness, that a mere mortal man, a seed of Abraham, should be called upon to baptize his God, his Lord, and his Creator, yes, the Mighty God of the far-flung uni-Christ thus humbled verse. Himself before His Father to fulfill all righteousness, setting the example for all mankind to follow.

Baptism is a simple thing, something even a child can understand, but like the foolishness of preaching, the world treats it lightly at best, or else mocks it as of no worth. When Christ entered His ministry the Pharisees and others were offended by Him, but the poor came to hear His words.

Then the day of His passion Could Judas have arrived. known the full significance of what he was doing when he gave his Lord the kiss of death? Then, as Christ stood in the judgment hall, could His interrogators have known to Whom they were directing their questions? Would they not have been humbled to the dust had they known He was God of the universe and the One to whom, one day, every knee should bow and confess as Lord, and His iudgments iust?

Then, those zealous ones pressed a crown of thorns upon His brow in mockery of His kingship. They spit upon Him and mocked Him, and He bore it all. And then stripes were administered as if He were a common criminal, leaving His back bloody and painful. How ashamed and mortified they will be when they come to realize that it was their God and their Creator that they had spit upon. How ashamed they will be when they remember how they whipped the God of the Universe and pressed that crown of thorns upon his brow in mockery of His claims. What a horrifying rebuke this will be to their unbelief. The Roman soldiery may have done it ignorantly. But as for the wicked Pharisees and others who plotted this deed, Christ, Himself said they had no cloak for their sin. These will receive a just recompense from God in the Day of Judgment.

But for the others Christ prayed, "Forgive them, for they know not what they do." Yet, nevertheless, they will certainly sorrow that they had, through force of circumstance, been caught in a time and place to be made unwitting participants in this great drama.

After this, Christ was taken to be crucified, it having pleased the Father to bruise Him. The soldiers who drove in the nails could not have known through Whose hands they were driving them. Had they known, they would have shrunk from the deed. One day they will stand before their Lord and ponder how fate could have so consigned them.

So He hung on the cross for



six long hours, taking upon Himself all our sins, suffering the chastisement of our sins in our stead, and this after having, a short time before, plead with God that this cup might pass from Him, in great agony, sweating drops of blood, that He might not undergo that fiery trial. But He yielded to the will of His Father in all things, even to death on the cross.

Had it not been so, all would have been lost. And then, that trial ended, and He descended to the depths of hell. His disciples were scattered and all seemed hopeless, yet on the third day came a glorious dawning, and the Lord of all came forth triumphantly and victoriously from the tomb. Death had been defeated, and He became the firstborn of them that believe. To Mary, He said, "Touch me not; for I have not yet ascended unto my Father." But her report was as wives' tales to the disciples. Nevertheless, He appeared to them, ate fish with them, and finally ascended into heaven, promising that as they had seen Him go so would He also return. And while the rest of the world lay in ignorance of these marvelous things, Christ went on to fulfill the remainder of His Father's commission, and over the next  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years visited the rest of the house of Israel.

What of the future? We know that He is coming back to claim all that is His own. But more than this, we will have fellowship with the God of our salvation, the One to whom all power in heaven and earth has been given. And then we, if we have endured unto the end, will live and reign with Him for a thousand years, and after that for an eternity on the new earth. What a conclusion it will be for those of us who have endured, for a moment, the trials and tribulations of this life, to inherit the glory, the joy, and the fellowship of the Lord throughout all the eternity to come. "For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory" (2 Corinthians 4:17). In truth, we cannot even imagine what the Lord has prepared for them that love Him. What a glorious prospect that lies before us.

In view of these things, let us be found worthy (not wanting) of this high calling, for we are all called to be saints. Let us therefore bring forth fruit meet for this calling.


Young Alex Gahner had ear surgery to remove a tumor and has recovered wonderfully.


well and he was released on June 13th and is recovering at home. He will need to have two more reconstructive surgeries in the next six months.

Iphas Odira died at the age of 72 on 21st, July 2011, in a hospital in Mwanza Tanzania, due to complications of a stroke. Elphas is survived by his wife, Angelina; eleven children: four sons and seven daughters; and 19 grandchildren. Elphas was a retired schoolteacher who taught English, and has served as the Coordinator for the Tanzania Church of Christ since 2002. Let me tell you a little of his story on how he helped the church take root in Tanzania.

After the church was well established in his own village in 2002, Elphas wasted no time in spreading the news of his church, and

arranged for us to go to many new places where he had family members or contacts that might be interested in the gospel. A good share of the 30 congregations we have presently in Tanzania can be attributed to Elphas making the contact, and he was always there to introduce us and arrange for our meetings, part of his duties as a coordinator.

October 29, 1959~June 3, 2011




The Lord blessed Ed throughout his life. Ed was a believer from the time he was a young boy until the day the Lord called him home into eternal life on June 3, 2011.
